TASK / ACTION	MATERIALS / EQUIPMENT
<p style="text-align: center;">1</p> <p>Arrive at customer location, review Service Report for current billing information. Meet with assigned contact and check log book before beginning service.</p>	<p>Service Report and any notes from previous services.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">2</p> <p>Inspect areas for evidence (feces, burrows, gnawing) of rodents.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Probing tool, Hand Rake Flashlight</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">3</p> <p>Observe through inspection, any pest colonies on the property perimeter. Provide direct application to eliminate these colonies when discovered. Apply appropriate species specific baits for pests observed in ornamental plant beds, parking lot islands, retention pond areas, etc.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Baits including but not limited to: Niban Granules, Extinguish Plus, Advion Fire Ant Bait Advion Mole Cricket Bait</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Centro Bulb Duster, Whirlybird Spreader</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">4</p> <p>Place and maintain rodent bait boxes (Protectas) in hidden, inconspicuous areas. The boxes must be tamper resistant and secured with 12 inch patio blocks. Total placements will vary. At least one station will be placed near the dumpster(s).</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Confrac Rodenticide Secured Rodent Stations (gray or black) Bait on skewers inside box. Boxes closed and secured with allen head screws. NO plastic ties. Hard surface anchors, patio blocks, liquid nails etc. used to secure stations in place.</p>

<p>5 Inspect adjacent mature ornamental plantings for pest presence. Apply species specific baits as warranted. Direct treat pest harborages.</p>	<p>Misc. baits including but not limited to: MaxForce granular bait, Niban granular bait, Granules, Terro, etc.</p> <p>Use per label directions.</p>
<p>6 If applicable, place fly bait receptacles adjacent to dumpsters. Recommend exterior illuminated light traps or mosquito attraction devices as appropriate. Monitor exterior light sources and type of light source. Recommend changes to reduce insect attraction from structural lights.</p>	<p>Victor Fly Magnet plus bait packet Stimukill Fly Bait & Bait Receptacle Mantis or other approved Illuminated Light Trap</p>
<p>7 Inspect areas for evidence of rodent burrows, Burrows should be baited and immediately closed with a soil seal.</p>	<p>Generation rodenticide in the form of weather resistant blocks. No place packs are to be used.</p>
